It is coming! It is coming with the great promise of seven wonderful tours awaiting your participation. New destinations, resorts revisited, and old favorites all hold the promise of another fantastic ski season.

It won't be long now. Those first snowflakes, then the first winter storm and the first big dump of snow in the mountains may cause others to cringe but all skiers will rejoice. We know celebrating winter generates vitality. Winter keeps us active. We understand that winter and its shoulder seasons are the most invigorating times of the year.

### Marmot Basin

Fortunately others recognize this as well. The staff at Marmot Basin are completing the installation of the replacement to Paradise Triple Chair. It will be suitably named "Paradise Express." At the same time,

they have relocated Paradise Triple to replace the old Schoolhouse T-bar, providing better access to the teaching zone and the parking lots. There are great videos of the installation process on the "skimarmot.com" website.

### Kicking Horse

While Marmot Basin has undoubtedly the largest summer improvement program, other resorts have been working hard to attract both your attention and your business. Kicking Horse has made one extensive improvement to their resort.

A website spokesperson wrote the following. "On mountain, our development team have just completed earth works on the new "Redemption Ridge Traverse." The new traverse will provide groomed access to the classic Kicking Horse terrain on Redemption Ridge. The traverse trail extends from the top of the Stairway To Heaven Chair along Redemption Ridge to Tower 10 and is designed to provide safer and easier access into Feuz Bowl and south facing runs in Crystal Bowl. This winter, our grooming teams will have the ability to maintain this traverse along with exploring new grooming options into Feuz Bowl and possibly some of the south facing terrain on Crystal Bowl."

The Superior Lodge Rooms are located on the second and third floors on the frozen waterfall side of the building. Each room features one queen bed and a single trundle bed and a flat-screen TV. There is a full bathroom with bathtub and shower.

- A bus has been booked. However, if fewer than 30 people make reservations the Club will cancel the bus, refund the cost (\$ 98 each) and attempt to arrange car pooling.
